PD Support Groups

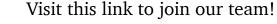
- Wednesday evening Parkinson's support group meets the first Wednesday of the month,

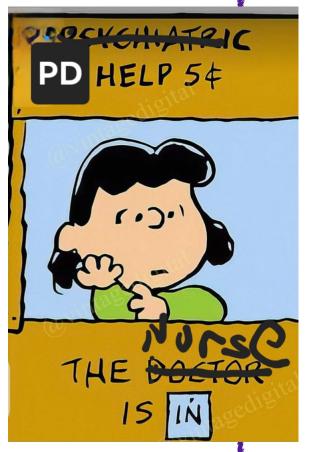
